

Notice to OJI Claimants

Date: December 1, 2015

Re: On-the-Job Injury Program – Pharmacy Benefits

Effective January 1, 2016, any employee or former employee receiving pharmacy benefits under the University of Alabama’s On-the-Job Injury (OJI) program will need to have all prescriptions filled at Tuscaloosa Drug Company at one of these three locations:

Please contact one of the three locations listed above to make arrangements to transfer your existing prescriptions. You may need to contact your treating physician if a refill authorization is required. To allow the pharmacy ample time to transfer your prescriptions, please make contact 5 to 7 days prior to running out of your medicine.

For your convenience, Tuscaloosa Drug Company offers local delivery or can mail your prescriptions in most cases. Once you have received your initial prescription from Tuscaloosa Drug Company, you have the option to order refills online at <http://www.tuscaloosadrugcompany.com/index.htm>.

This change is necessary due to a change in the University’s employee health plan and only impacts the OJI pharmacy benefits you receive. If you are enrolled in the University’s health plan as an employee, eligible dependent, or retiree, you will receive details on upcoming changes to the health plan pharmacy benefits in a separate notice. This notice only applies to the medicine related to your on-the-job injury.

The UA OJI program will not pay for any prescriptions including reimbursement for your co-payments or deductibles if dispensed at any pharmacy other than Tuscaloosa Drug Company.
